beautifying.

Vision: Preserving the traditional and civilized inheritance and protecting and presenting it in a modern

sustainable manner, consistent with the best international standards.

Mission: Executing policies related to antiquities in Jordan, in order to maintain the civilized inheritance,

through field studies, restoration and excavation works in antiquities locations.

#### Tasks of the Ministry / Department:

- Assist in organizing museums for government activities in the Kingdom including historic, technical and popular museums.
- Implement archaeological policy of the country.
- Archaeological assessment of all archaeological sites and estimation the importance of each one.
- Control the acquisition and disposal of antiquities as per the provisions of antiquities law and regulations, decisions and instructions issued thereunder.
- Archaeological exploration in the Kindom.

#### Ministry/Department Contribution to the National Objectives:

- Spread the archeological culturel and establish archeological and legacy museums taking into account the provisions of applicable legisaltions.
- \_ Spread archaeological awareness as per the provisions of issued instructions, regulations and laws.
- Cooperate with local, Arab and foreign archaeological entities to serve the national legacy.


#### Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department:




