- Accept private and public, local and foreign institutions requests to hold commercial and industrial exhibitions in the Kingdom and regulate exhibitions of Jordanian products abroad.

- _ Enable the national economy to accommodate the growing flow of Jordanian labor.

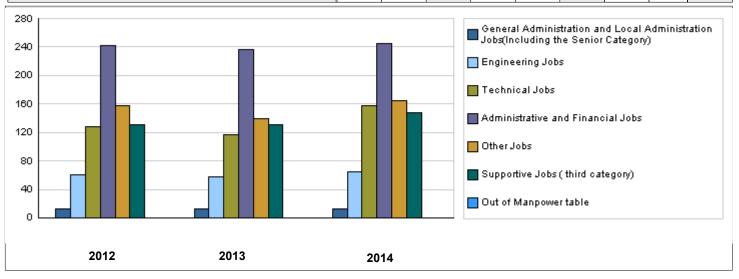

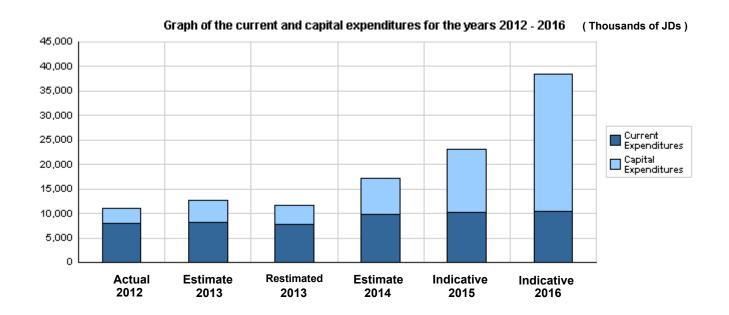

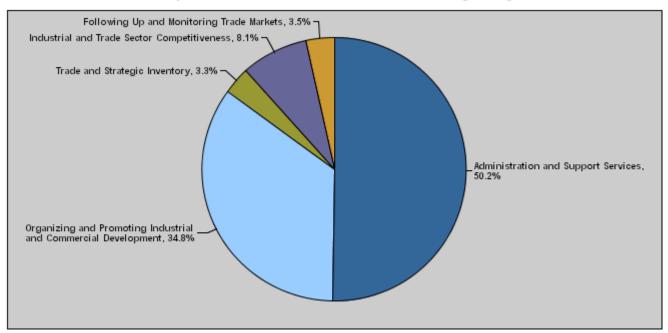


Budget of Chapter 1601 - Ministry of Industry and Trade For the Year 2014 Distributed According to Program
