Chapter: 1110 Judiciary Council

Creation: The history of the judiciary in Jordan dates back to the early years of establishment of the Amirate

of Trans-Jordan, it's one of the three powers of the State of Jordan. The Judicial Council of Jordan represents the top of the authority pyramid of in the kingdom, aimed at achieving justice, equality and protection of the rights and freedoms through the strengthening of the rule of law. According to the Constitution of Jordan the Judicial Power shall be exercised by the courts of law in their varying types and degrees. All judgements shall be given in accordance with the law and pronounced in the name of the King. Judges are independent, and in the exercise of their judicial

functions they are subject to no authority other than that of the law.

Vision: An independent judicial authority that safeguards justice, and ensures the rights and freedoms.

Mission: Judicial authority achieves justice, with its pillar the Rule of Law and contributes to providing

appropriate judicial environment and integration with partners to support the reform and

comprehensive development efforts.

Legal Framework: Independence of the Judiciary Law No.(29) of 2014 and amendments and regulations made

thereunder, and Judicial Institute's Bylaw No. (6) of 2010.

Tasks of the Ministry / Department:

Consider judges affairs, their appointment, promotion, discipline, transfer, assignment secondment and termination in accordance with the provisions of the law.

- _ Give opinion on the legislation related to the judiciary and submitting suggestions thereon.
- Endorse the annual report on the status and the functioning of courts
- Request from any official department or elsewhere the data and documents it deems necessary.

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

Consolidate the State of law and institutions, achieve full justice and promote the principles of equal opportunity, transparency and protection of rights and freedoms.

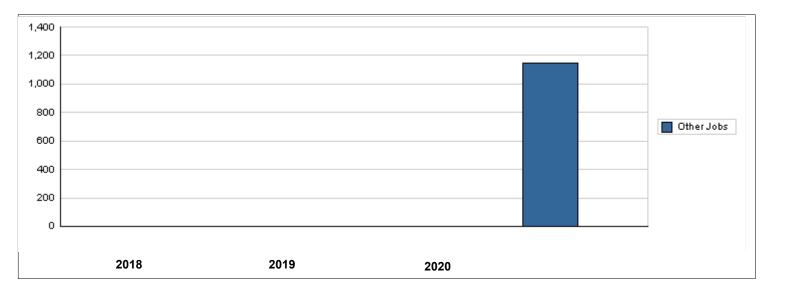

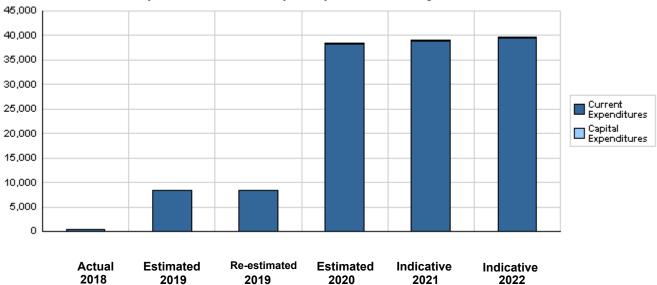

Graph of the current and capital expenditures for the years 2018 - 2022

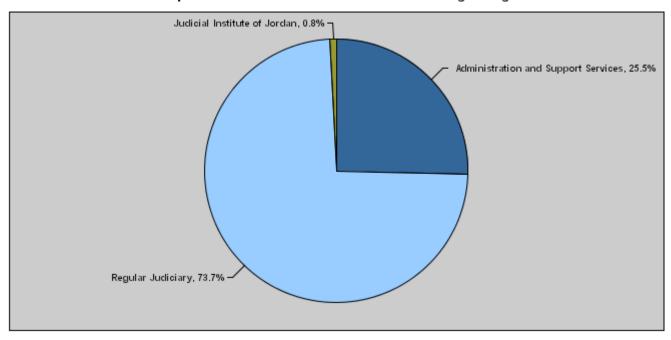
