Financial Administration and Planning Sector

Key differences between the estimated appropriations for 2024 and the re-estimation for 2023 of the sector :

Current expenditure:

- The increase in the financial management and planning sector for 2024 compared to the reestimated for the year 2023 at (537.6) million JDs. This increase was concentrated on:
- Compensations of employees increased by (9) million JDs, this is to cover the cost of the natural increase in the salaries and wages group and to make provision for the cost of vacancies and new jobs for 2024
- The use of goods and salaries group appropriations increased by (59) million JDs, this increase was concentrated in the Ministry of Finance owing to an increase in emergency expenditure allocations of (40) million JDs in addition to an increase in public expenditure allocations of (12.8) million JDs and provision for the holding of the 2024 parliamentary elections.
- Debt interest allocations (internal and external) increased in the amount of (277) million JDs to cover interest on internal loans and external loans interests.
- Retirement and compensation allowances increased by approximately (78) million JDs to cover the cost of salaries of civilian and military retirees and the cost of salaries of new retirees during 2024.
- The general tax reimbursements on sales and income tax reimbursements increased by (17) million JDs.

Capital expenditure:

- Capital expenditures for the financial management and planning sector for 2024 decreased with a re-estimated of the year 2023 of approximately at (18.3) million JDs owing to the termination of some projects. Nevertheless, allocations for a number of existing projects increased, notably:
- Allocation of the support services and infrastructure project increased by (1.3) million JDs in the Customs Department budget and the allocation of the project for the construction of buildings for anti-smuggling and customs escort centers increased by (900) thousand JDs in the customs budget.
- Allocations for economic vision initiatives and the transition to a green economy increased by (2.2) million JDs within the budget of the Ministry of Planning.
- Allocations for economic vision initiatives and the transition to a green economy increased by (2.2) million JDs within the budget of the Ministry of Planning.
- Allocation of (7) million JDs to the General Population and Housing Census project in the Department of General Statistics's budget.
- The allocation for the family expenditure and income survey project in the amount of (685) thousand JDs within the budget of the Department of General Statistics.
- The Dead Sea East Beach Development Project's allocation increased by (600) thousand JDs.
