#### Chapter: 1601 Ministry of Industry, Trade and Supply

Creation:

The Ministry of Industry and Trade was established in 1952 under the name of Ministry of Economy and Trade. Under Ministry of National Economy Regulation and Administration Bylaw No. (12) for the year 1971, it became to be known as the Ministry of National Economy. In line with the international economic developments, Jordan's direction towards economic and trade openness and enhancement of the free economy mechanisms and market forces, Industry and Trade Law No. (18) for the year 1998 was issued; under which the Ministry of Supply was cancelled and its directorates were merged with the directorates of the Ministry of Industry and Trade as the legal successor of the Ministry of Supply then the supply pillar was returned as the main pillar to become the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Supply in 2013 due to the instability of prices of basic materials that ensure food security for the Jordanian citizen.

Vision: Entrepreneurship and competitiveness in the development of a sustainable national economy.

Mission: Developing economic policies and programmes and enhancing the business environment to be

more competitive and contributing by strengthening strategic inventory and strengthening

partnership with all stakeholders.

Legal Framework: Industry and Trade Law No. (18) for the year 1998, and amendments thereto.

#### Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2024 - 2026 :

#### **First Priority:**

- Promoting food security.

#### Key procedures to realize the first priority:

- A bid has been made for the implementation of Ghabawi grains containers with a capacity of (100) thousand tons of Ghabawi grains, and 65% of the project has been implemented.
- \_ A bid has been made for the implementation of Qatraneh grains containers with a capacity of (500) thousand tons of Qatraneh grains, and 30% of the project has been implemented.

#### **First Priority Outcomes:**

Raising the inventory capacity of grains (wheat and barley) from (1.6) million tons currently to be(2.35) million tons.

- \_ Establishment of a national coordination mechanism for electronic commerce.
- Launching pilot projects in high priority inputs to enhance the competitiveness of micro, small and medium enterprises.

- **\_** Enabling work environment for e-commerce in Jordan
- \_ Supporting small and medium companies and companies owned by women in the transition to online selling

#### fourth priority-related program:

- \_ Organization and Promotion Program for Industrial and Commercial Development.
- **\_ Industrial and Commercial Sector Competitiveness Program.**

#### **Five Priority:**

 Promoting the performance of monitoring role to control prices and addressing monopoly policies in the different economic sectors.

#### Key procedures to realize the fifth priority:

- The violations system has been launched and the number of data segments has been increased so that all market monitors have the feature of live broadcasting.
- \_ A database (price monitor) has been completed.

#### **Five Priority Outcomes:**

- Developing control on markets system and promote transparency in investigating violations.
- \_ Establishing a price observatory to control all variables to goods prices.
- \_ Reinforcing competitiveness policies through raising awareness of competition provisions.

#### Fifth priority-related program:

\_ Market Monitoring and Follow-up Program.

#### Sixth Priority:

\_ Facilitating business environment.

#### Key procedures to realize the sixth priority:

- The "Directory" platform, which includes an electronic procedure manual for the registration and licensing of economic activities, has been developed and established
- \_ Starting the development of fast track system in cooperation with registration and licensing stakeholders.

#### **Sixth Priority Outcomes:**

- Establishing unified electronic record to register economic activities and unified authority responsible for registering these activities
- Streamlining and eliminating sectoral licensing (simplifying licensing for educational institutions, revoking tourism licensing and replacing it with the classification system).
- Preparing electronic procedures manual and simplifying unconditional licenses (municipal, environmental).
- \_ Improving business registration and licensing within the quick lane.

#### Sixth priority-related program:

Administration and Support Services Program.

#### Priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

Empowerment of women.

Key procedures to realize the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- \_ The Unit's functions have been finalized.
- A proposed program has been developed to promote women's and youth participation in the food industry sector.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

Establishment of a Women's Empowerment Unit within the Ministry to empower women economically through coordination with all relevant bodies to consolidate efforts to promote women's participation in the Jordanian economy.

Priority-related program of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

\_ Industrial and Commercial Sector Competitiveness Program.

#### Priority of climate change:

\_ Applying the green economy system concept in the industrial companies.

Key procedures to realize climate change-related priority:

- An agreement was signed between the Ministry of Industry, Trade and Supply and the Royal Scientific Society to prepare studies to implement integrated resource efficiency and cleaner production practices applied in industrial facilities in cooperation with the Ministry of Environment, the Chamber of Industry of Jordan and the Royal Scientific Society.
- Receiving factory requests to take advantage of the project.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of climate change:

Promoting shifting to green economy in the Jordanian industries and companies to increase their competitiveness and productivity,reduce their operational expenditure and finding more job opportunities.

Program of climate change-related priority:

- Organization and Promotion Program for Industrial and Commercial Development.

#### Tasks of the Ministry / Department:

- Business Environment pillar: contributing to the development of investment legislation, simplifying procedures, automating services, promoting creativity and innovation.
- Supply and internal trade pillar: securing a strategic stock of wheat and barley, controlling markets and consumer protection, regulating e-commerce legislatively and operationally, and strengthening partnership with the commercial sector.
- Industry pillar: developing industrial sectors and enhancing their competitiveness internally and externally, strengthening partnerships with the industrial productive sector, focusing on high-value industries, enhancing the sustainability of industrial sectors and providing support to this end.
- Foreign trade pillar: supporting exports of industrial and service sectors, concluding free trade agreements, opening new non-traditional markets

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

- Creating an attractive investment environment capable of attracting foreign capitals and encouraging local investments.
- Realizing sustainable growth rates to ensure good level of living for all citizens.
- Reducing poverty and unemployment levels and build effective social protection system.

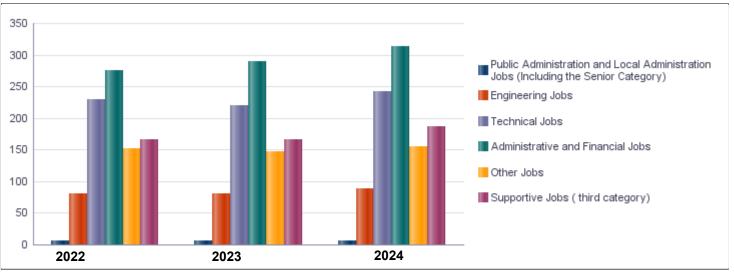

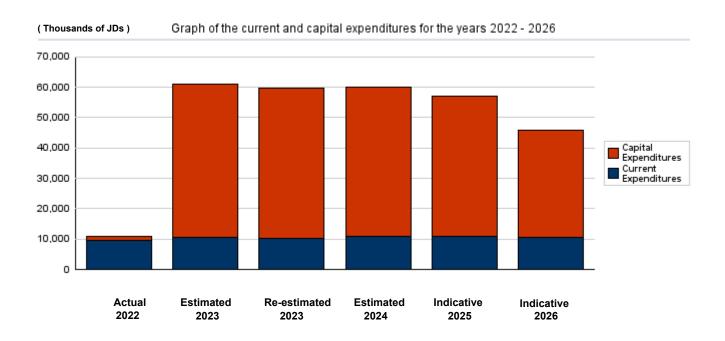
#### Most notable differences between estimated appropriations for 2024 and re-estimated for 2023

#### **Current expenditure:**

- Compensations of employees group increased by (514) thousand JDs, to cover the natural annual increase and cover the cost of vacancies, new jobs and other appointments, transferred and reduce cost of terminating staff members' services.
- Operational expenditure increased by (30) thousand JDs, concentrated mostly in security and guard service contracts, commercial centers, advertisements and subscriptions items.
- Other expenditure increased by (50) thousand JDs concentrated in ships surplus item account.

#### Capital expenditure:

- Capital expenditures reduced by (177) thousand JDs, as a result of the following:-
- Increased economic modernization vision projects by (3.84) million JDs, most notably the project to increase the storage capacity of grain absorbers (100) thousand tons in Gbawi by (3.5) million JDs.
- The Ministry's other projects decreased by (3.93) million JDs, most notably the decrease in the project of exhibitions and export promotion by (3.65) million JDs.
- Decrease in governorates (decentralization) projects by (87) thousand JDs.
