Chapter: 2501 Ministry of Education

Creation: The first Ministry of Education bylaw was issued in 1939. The Ministry is responsible for the

educational system pursuant to the provisions of Education Law No. (3) for the year 1994, and amendments thereto, which includes complete details related to the philosophy of education, its goals and the educational policy principles as well as the Ministry's work, tasks, staff, educational stages, the tasks of the Education Council, the principles of curricula and textbooks, general

examinations and private and foreign educational institutions.

Vision: A pioneering, belonging, educational and participating community committed to values, with its

approach science and excellence and reaching for globalism.

Mission: Providing equal opportunities to high-quality education that would enable the learner to have

critical scientific and creative thinking, to work as a team, to have life-long learning and to acquire skills and values: so that they could become active citizens belonging to their country and

contributing to the welfare of the world and humanity.

Legal Framework: Education Law No. (3) and amendments thereto for the year 1994.

Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2024 - 2026:

First Priority:

Early education and childhood development: increasing children's - males & females - access opportunities to quality early childhood education and their willingness to learn for life.

Key procedures to realize the first priority:

_ Expanding the construction and equipping of kindergarten suites and rooms.

First Priority Outcomes:

- _ Increasing children's access opportunities to early childhood education and expending in these services.
- _ Increasing the readiness of children for learning.
- Development of a unified quality assurance system for kindergartens (government and private sectors).
- _ Increasing children with disabilities enrolment to kindergartens.

First priority-related program:

_ 4422- Education for kindergartens (early childhood development pillar).

Second Priority:

Vocational Education pillar: Increasing access to vocational education and improving its quality.

Key procedures to realize the second priority:

- Increasing awareness and guidance for students and parents in the importance of vocational and technical education.
- Expanding the establishment of professional schools, classroom additions and specialized professional workshops and equipping them with the latest electronic machines to be in keeping with the age of technology.

Second Priority Outcomes:

- National framework for the vocational education sector: establishment of a higher advisory committee to develop the general framework for the vocational education sector (Ministry of Labour, Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, National Centre for Curriculum Development and the Private Sector).
- Increasing participation in the vocational education: percentages of vocational program enrolment to total secondary stage enrolment.
- Improving the quality of vocational education: qualified and trained teachers more effectively for vocational education.
- Reaching developed partnerships among government institutions and private sector institutions.
- Modernizing students distribution system after the ninth class to meet labor markets requirements.

Second priority-related program:

4405- Vocational education (vocational education pillar).

Third Priority:

- Human Resources Development pillar: the provision, development and sustainability of qualified human resources for the educational system.

Key procedures to realize the third priority:

 Developing training materials for new teachers and in-service teachers, and sustainably providing the necessary tools.

- The existance of improved methodologies and mechanisms for teachers' selection, recruitment and preservice qualification.
- Setting out improved mechanism to select leaderships in all administrative levels.
- _ Vocational development and improved licenses for teachers during the service.
- Developing quality control, follow-up and evaluation framework for vocational development policies.

Third priority-related program:

■ 4440- Human resources development (human resources pillar).

Fourth Priority:

Quality pillar: the quality of education is improved to prepare a productive and good citizen belongs to his country.

Key procedures to realize the fourth priority:

- _ Working on curriculum development.
- _ Keeping abreast of technological developments in education.
- _ Development of work based on the directorate and the school.
- Conducting preventive maintenance of schools.

Fourth Priority Outcomes:

- The revised national curriculum takes into account gender and human rights concepts that meet growing needs and the modified national assessment system.
- _ Improvement in the use of information and education technology use by students.
- **School leadership and enhanced community participation.**
- _ Improving the performance of schools.
- Providing attractive, stimulating and risk-free educational environment.

fourth priority-related program:

4445- Education Quality Development (quality pillar).

Five Priority:

 System Support pillar: strengthening a system of education that achieves innovation and excellence for effective education policies that contribute to achieving the priority objectives of Jordan's education sector.

Key procedures to realize the fifth priority:

- Adopting improved organizational performance.
- _ Implementation of the directorate's and school's project.
- Linking the Educational Management Information System (EMIS) with the Geographic Information System (GIS).

Five Priority Outcomes:

- Improved system to manage the institutional performance and connect individual performance with the institutional performance.
- Updated School & Directorate Development Program (SDDP) so that the Ministry's annual plans are prepared based on the needs of its actual directorates and schools.
- _ Improvement in administrative and educational services provided by the Ministry of Education.
- _ Updated and effective educational and geographic information management system.
- _ Institutionalizing risks and crises management system in the Ministry.

Fifth priority-related program:

_ 4450- Educational system support (system support pillar).

Priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

_ Access and equality pillar: access, expansion and equality for students of both females, inclusion of all age groups in education, increased access to education for all children with disabilities, and for all residents of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

Key procedures to realize the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

- Safe infrastructure that facilitates the integration of students with special needs into government schools (inclusive education).
- Providing advanced diagnostic tools for students with special needs.
- **Expansion of the non-formal education program.**

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- _ Providing safe schools for easy access.
- _ Physical environment for schools with preventive maintenance and provision of air conditioning systems.
- _ Developing competencies related to disabilities diagnosis.
- _ Expanding access to inclusive education.
- Programs and activities promoting the development and investment of talented students and their skills in all fields
- _ Providing informal education opportunities.

Priority-related program of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

- _ 4415- Special Education (access and equality pillar).
- 4425- Primary Education (access and equality pillar).
- 4430- Secondary Education (access and equality pillar).
- 4435- Literacy and adult education (access and equality pillar).

Priority of climate change:

- _ Green schools (partnership with private sector schools project).

Key procedures to realize climate change-related priority:

- _ Using solar energy to rationalize spending.
- _ Establishing school buildings in partnership with the private sector.
- Construction of winter water collection wells for use in irrigation and cleaning matters in schools to rationalize expenditure.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of climate change:

- _ Providing huge schools with solar energy.
- Obtaining green eco-friendly building certification from the Royal Scientific Society, especially for schools established by USAID & KFW.
- _ Using recycled water in irrigating some plants through the use of available energy systems.

Program of climate change-related priority:

- **4425- Primary Education (access and equality pillar).**
- 4430- Secondary Education (access and equality pillar).

Tasks of the Ministry / Department:

- Establishing, managing government educational institutions of all types and levels and providing qualified human resources and necessary educational materials thereto.
- Providing the government educational institutions with buildings suitable for education and distributing them in line with the educational policy.
- _ Supervising all private educational institutions to ensure their adherence to the provisions of education law.
- _ Establishing centers for adult education and irregular studies.
- Encouraging the activities of students in educational institutions and regulating the affairs of these activities in all sports, scouting, arts, cultural, social, and productive fields to achieve educational objectives in the various educational stages.
- _ Enhancing educational links between the Kingdom and other countries in the world.
- Providing necessary means and capacities to secure good life and stability for all employees in the Ministry.
- Providing appropriate protective health and guidance care in the government educational institutions and supervising their availability at the appropriate level in the private educational institutions.
- Enhancing relationship between the educational institution and its local community by establishing local boards for schools and boards for parents and teachers and activating the activities related to community service and voluntary work and other works which contribute to developing and improving the community.

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

- Expanding the opportunities to obtain primary and secondary education and improve the efficiency of education system.
- _ Expanding the establishment of kindergartens and focus on the poor and remote areas.
- Increasing the participation of private sector in vocational education and develop programs and curricula to meet the requirements of labor market.
- _ Improving the quality of primary and secondary education.

Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department :

- _ The impact of the coronavirus pandemic on the educational process (educational loss of schoolchildren).
- The increase in reverse migration from private schools to public schools which increases pressure on public school infrastructure and education indicators in general (the consequences of the coronavirus crisis and declining living standards).
- _ Higher costs as a result of the global wave of inflation and its impact on the Ministry's procurement and needs, which increases pressure on the Ministry's budget in the light of weak funding (difficulty in achieving financial efficiency of government expenditure on education).
- Achieving financial sustainability in accessing international financial support and changing priorities for donors of education programs (Syrian Asylum Support, Gender) as well as requirements for adopting educational initiatives and programs by international donor and lending agencies and institutions.
- The modernization and development of Jordan's educational system in keeping with the requirements of modern times and lessons learned from the coronavirus pandemic, in line with the approved education strategy.

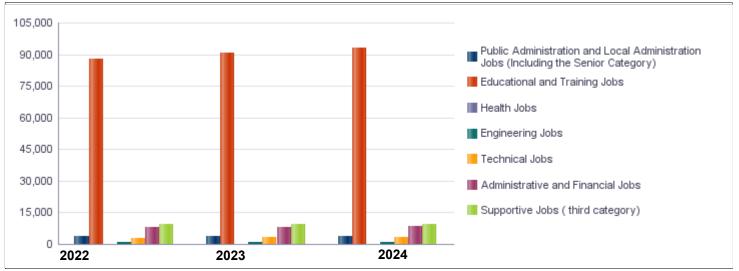

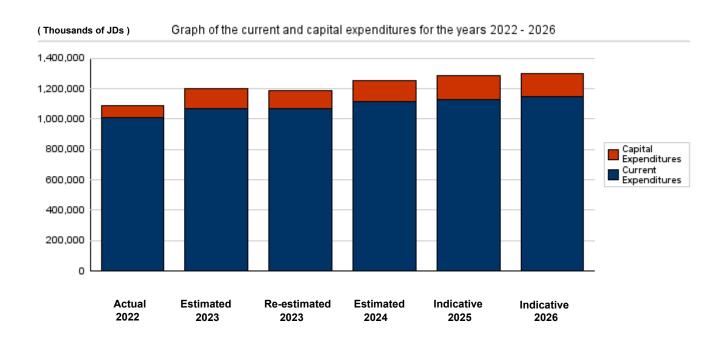
Most notable differences between estimated appropriations for 2024 and re-estimated for 2023

Current expenditure:

- Compensations of employees group increased by approximately (40.1) million JDs as a result of the natural increase in salaries, wages, allowances and the cost of hiring on vacancies and new jobs.
- Operational expenditure increased by approximately (3.6) million JDs. The increase concentrated on the items of water, electricity, maintenance of machinery and furniture, stationery and prints, school nutrition, rental of vehicles and wages of general secondary examiners.
- Other expenditure increased by (736) thousand JDs due to the increase of students with disabilities.

Capital expenditure:

- Capital expenditures increased by approximately (19.9) million JDs, this increase was a result of the following:-
- Increased allocation of (1.5) million JDs for Saudi loan-funded school construction projects and support to the National Curriculum Development Centre of approximately (1.4) million JDs, Maintenance and repairs of buildings for basic education in the amount of (4) million JDs and the construction of school buildings/Cities and Villages Development Bank of (2.4) million JDs; The project to print textbooks in the amount of (3) million JDs and the project of addition to the buildings of vocational education schools in the amount of (2) million JDs; The project to develop the system of excellence in King Abdullah II Schools of Excellence in the amount of (1) million JDs.
- Establishment of the inclusive education project for students with disabilities in the amount of (12) million JDs and the project to establish school buildings in partnership with the private sector PPP in the amount of (1)million JDs.
- Reduction in the allocation of (1.4) million JDs for the construction project and the addition of classrooms for basic education Basic Education Program Management Project in the amount of (2) million JDs and Basic Education School Building Construction Project funded by the Kuwaiti Loan in the amount of (1) million JDs kindergarten classroom additions project in the amount of (2) million JDs, The infrastructure project for the acquisition of distance education devices in the amount of (2) million JDs, and decentralization projects in the amount of (1.1) million JDs.
