Creation: The Ministry of Higher Education & Scientific Research was established in 1985 under Law No. (28)

for the year 1985 with aim of implementing the general policy of higher education in its fields of educational, cultural, learning, scientific and research within the Higher Education institutions and practice its tasks and powers to achieve the objectives of Higher Education pursuant to the

provisions of Higher Education and Scientific Research Law No. (17) for the year 2018.

Vision: Towards a high quality attractive higher education model and an outstanding scientific research

region-wide replicates the leading international practices.

Mission: Improving the services system within the quality and competetiveness frame to contribute to

meeting the requirements of current and future labor market.

Legal Framework: Higher Education and Scientific Research Law No. (17) for the year 2018, and amendments thereto.

Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2024 - 2026 :

First Priority:

Rooting the principle of the rule of law in the Ministry's work and apply good governance at all levels and develop governing legislations.

Key procedures to realize the first priority:

Developing the staff through training and providing them with the necessary skills to carry out the tasks, conducting training programs related to good governance to develop the skills of employees and raise awareness of them in addition to activating the Code of Career Conduct, reviewing and updating the legislation governing the work of the Ministry, providing opinion and legal advice and activating the work of administrative, financial and technical oversight.

First Priority Outcomes:

- Providing fair opportunities based on the principles enjoying equality for all qualified students according to competency and capacities.
- Providing educational opportunities based on fairness and equality for all students.

First priority-related program:

_ Government colleges and universities.

Second Priority:

Promoting cooperation system within participatory framework with the international and local educational institutions and private sector.

Key procedures to realize the second priority:

Continuous coordination and representation of the Ministry in various committees, events, projects and local and international initiatives, monitoring the progress of projects such as the Jordanian response plan to the Syrian crisis and following up on projects in support of the education process funded by supporting agencies in cooperation and coordination with the Ministry of Planning and International Cooperation.

Second Priority Outcomes:

- Preparing human staffs to meet the needs of current and future labor markets within quality and competitiveness framework.
- Reducing poverty and unemployment levels and build social protection system.
- Raising stakeholders' awareness of the importance of higher education and the national gains reflected in order to enhance their participation in higher education.

Second priority-related program:

_ Government colleges and universities.

Priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- _ Building a generation capable of innovation and creativity with high productivity.
- _ Providing requirements related to persons with disabilities.

Key procedures to realize the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

The Ministry works to empower women by directing female students to study certain disciplines and focusing on technical education in public universities. In addition, 150 points are allocated to students with disability ratios in accordance with the instructions of the Student Support Fund. This gives students with disabilities priority to obtaining grants and loans, as well as providing seats in Jordanian government universities to Jordanian women children with 200 seats through the Unified Admission Coordination Unit.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- Providing and ensuring the right of persons with disabilities to access education.

Priority-related program of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

_ Government colleges and universities.

Priority of climate change:

_ Ability to face any climate changes and make all conditions appropriate and attractive to students.

Key procedures to realize climate change-related priority:

The Ministry works to address any climate changes and seeks to focus on the exploitation of alternative energy and focus on projects that serve this priority through the establishment of research platforms focusing on climate change and waste as well as the preparation of a disaster and crisis response plan.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of climate change:

- **_** Changing the types of education and focusing on technological aspects.
- _ Adopting the digital solutions and continuous development of the IT projects.

Program of climate change-related priority:

- _ Administration and Support Services
- _ Government colleges and universities.

Tasks of the Ministry / Department :

- Implementing the general policy of high education in its educational, cultural, teaching, scientific and research fields in high education institutions.
- Coordinating between the higher education institutions and public and private consultations centers in the Kingdom to utilize their educational, research and consultative capacities in optimal way.
- Concluding scientific and cultural agreements related to higher education that promote cooperation in the cultural and scientific fields with relevant institutions in the Arab, foreign and islamic countries and the regional and international organizations.
- _ Representing the Kingdom in local and foreign seminars and conferences related to the higher education.
- Recognizing the Non-Jordanian higher education institutions and equializing certificates issued by them as per a bylaw issued for this end.
- Setting out the foundations for delegating scholarships in higher education institutions inside and outside the Kingdom and regulate the issues of delegation and supervise it.
- _ Following up the affairs of Jordanian students abroad.
- Organizing the affairs of students coming to the Kingdom and its deployed students, and matters of scientific delegations in cooperation and coordination with the relevant authorities.
- Preparing and providing qualified administrative and technical bodies are capable of carrying out the council's tasks and following up its affairs.
- Providing the council with any available studies, information and data related to higher education and scientific research.
- Organizing the affairs of offices that provide services to students of higher education and determining their licensing fees and the penalties imposed for violating them according to a bylaw to be issued for this purpose.
- Providing grants and loans for students in the official universities as per a bylaw issued for this end.
- Organizing and supervising scholarships issues to implement the agreements and educational exchange programs between the Kingdom and other countries and institutions according to a bylaw to be issued for this purpose.

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives :

- Preparing talents to meet the requirements of the future, resources and institutions capable of accelerating Jordanian economic growth and quality of life goals.
- Promoting sustainable practices as an integral part of Jordan's future economic growth and improving quality of life.
- Providing equitable opportunities based on equality for all qualified students based on merit and abilities.
- Raising the standards and quality of scientific research outputs and the level of teaching and learning in higher education systems in line with the best methods and standards in advanced universities.
- Encouraging universities to assume greater responsibility for making concrete contributions to national economic and social goals.
- Adopting international best practices in teaching and learning that will support better educational and quality opportunities.
- Raising stakeholders' awareness of the importance of higher education and the national gains reflected in order to enhance their participation in higher education.

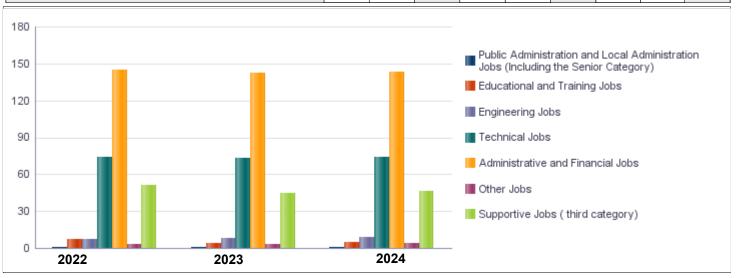
Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department :

- University Admission: Increased numbers of students in universities and their increasing percentage to faculty members, unequal opportunities and weakness in the educational system and its inability to prepare graduates with competencies in line with the labor market requirements.
- _ Technical Education: Reduced percentage of students enrolled in technical education to the total students in the higher education sector has led to an increase in the unemployment rate among university graduates.
- Education Quality: lack of effective quality system in universities that focus on distinguished preparation for learning outcomes and optimal use of resources and sources, integrated Foundation for University environment, infrastructure and efficiency of governance and management.
- Scientific Research: weakness of the research and creative production in universities and lack of applied research for scientific matters related to national priorities and non-availability of financing sources, components, mechanisms and stimulated systems for research and creativity.
- Conditions in neighbouring States increase the number of Jordanian students returning from abroad and the sudden return of students from some States as a result of political and security instability.
- _ The limited financial resources available in the Student Support Fund in view of the increasing numbers of applicants.

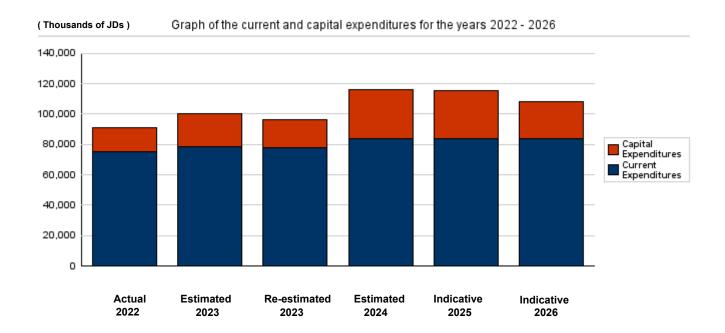
Most notable differences between estimated appropriations for 2024 and re-estimated for 2023

- Subsidies for non-financial public institutions: Increased by (5120) thousand JDs. This increase is concentrated on an increase in the allocation of (5) thousand JDs to support public universities.

Capital expenditure :

- Increased by (14327) thousand JDs, concentrated on increasing the allocation of decentralization projects by (1893) thousand JDs, and allocating new appropriations for the cultural exchange students' accommodation project in the amount of (774) thousand JDs and increasing the allocation of projects committed to by (11660) thousand JDs, most notably the project to support the student in need fund by (10000) thousand JDs and the project for the development of technical education in official universities (Gulf grant) in the amount of (1480) thousand JDs;
