Chapter: 8169 Jordan Airports Company

Creation: In order to implement the government's plan to restructure the civil aviation sector, on the basis of

the separating importance between the management and operation of airports on the one hand, regulating the aviation sector on the other hand, where the responsibility for managing airports and regulating the aviation sector was previously entrusted to one party, the Civil Aviation

Regulatory Authority, the Council of Ministers decided on 27/5/2008 to approve the establishment of the Jordan Airports Company as a private shareholding company wholly owned by the government, where the company was established on 28/12/2008 as a private limited shareholding company, and

was registered under No. (601) with the Companies Control Department.

Vision: To become the distinguished company in supplying aviation and airports infrastructure services in

the Middle East.

Mission: Providing the airports and their users with administrative, technical and operational services

according to the international standards of efficiency, quality, safety and security.

Legal Framework: Council of Ministers' decision No. (3404), taken in its session held on 2/12/2008.

Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2024 - 2026:

First Priority:

Implementation of capital and investment projects aimed at licensing Amman Airport by the Jordan Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission, thereby operating the airport and eliminating the airport usage limitation imposed by the Jordan Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission since late 2017.

Key procedures to realize the first priority:

- Completion of capital projects, notably completion of the tender of the project "Rehabilitation of Amman Airport runway II (Part I) Ruddam Al-Wadi north of the runway", which is one of the reasons why Amman Civil Airport is not operating to receive regular and tourist flights implemented during 2023-2024.
- Constantly monitoring project performance and evaluating results to improve processes and avoiding imbalances and increased costs.

First Priority Outcomes:

- Eliminating the determination of airport uses imposed by the Civil Aviation Regulatory Commission and thereby maximizing and doubling the Airport's revenues, which will have a positive impact on the financial surpluses transferred to the Ministry of Finance significantly.
- _ Increased air traffic and increased passenger numbers.

First priority-related program:

_ Sustaining and operating airports.

Second Priority:

Achieving international and local security requirements and strengthening Jordanian airport infrastructure to attract international airlines and tourism, as well as reducing the operational cost of the airport after the implementation of the photovoltaic project and working to increase reliance on solar energy in the future.

Key procedures to realize the second priority:

- _ Continuous updating of security technologies and systems where tender has been completed "to provide consultancy engineering services (studies and designs) for the implementation of the security barrier at Al Masafa Street/Amman Civil Airport in preparation for the implementation of the security barrier tender to meet international and local security requirements in 2023-2024.
- Compliance with international and local safety and security regulations and standards and enhancement of infrastructure. A bid for "illuminated guidance boards and illuminated guidance boards" was completed in 2023 in preparation for future infrastructure improvement.
- _ Completion of the implementation and operation of the Alternative Energy Project.

Second Priority Outcomes:

- Upgrading the efficiency inspection devices and modernize devices in Amman civil airport during the years 2024-2026
- Reduction of the value of electricity invoice of Jordan Airports Company by 43%-45%, thereby reducing the operational costs by 350.000 JDs per year.
- Completion of infrastructure capital projects during the first half of 2024 and the completion of the bid for implementation during the fourth quarter of the current year 2023, as work is still underway during the current year as well.

Second priority-related program:

_ Sustaining and operating airports.

Priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

 Providing an opportunity to recruit youth staff and persons with disabilities by engaging them and integrating them into the community.

Key procedures to realize the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- Conducting training and development programs that promote growth and professional development opportunities for all employees equally.
- Developing policies that provide for equality and diversity in all aspects of work, including employment, promotion and working conditions.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- Working to provide and create jobs that do not require high skills and commensurate with technical or practical qualifications during 2024-2026
- Raising the efficiency of corporate performance in the company.

Priority-related program of gender, youth and persons with disabilities :

_ Administration and Support Services.

Priority of climate change:

Providing the appropriate environment for adaptation in the aircraft's area of operation by reducing the emission of fuel released from aircraft and taking the necessary precautions.

Key procedures to realize climate change-related priority:

- A move towards sustainable energy through the adoption of alternative energy use strategies. A photovoltaic tender was launched at the end of 2022 and percentage of (90%) of the alternative energy project was completed in 2023 to supply renewable energy electricity to Amman Civil Airport to reduce the operational cost of the airport.
- Needs analysis and selection of appropriate devices that correspond to the company's needs in terms of quality and efficiency and conform to international and local regulations and requirements.
- Identifying the main bases for selecting staff with the necessary skills for specific tasks with relevant expertise and ensuring that they conform to health and safety standards.

The following outcomes are expected to be realized for the priority of climate change:

- Working on the recruitment of public safety cadres from engineers and others in the area of operation of aircraft to work on reducing the peripheral effects in the region during the period 2024-2026.
- Increased dependence on alternative energy.
- Providing appropriate devices that meet safety standards and comply with international and local regulations and requirements.

Program of climate change-related priority:

_ Sustaining and operating airports.

Tasks of the Ministry / Department :

- _ Amman Civil Airport management and operation.
- _ Managing and operating air freight facilitations center in Queen Alia International Airport.
- Investment of government lands surrounding the site invested by the International Airport Group at Queen Alia International Airport.
- _ Investing Amman Civil Airport facilities and lands/ Marka.

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

- Creating an attractive investment environment capable of attracting foreign capitals and encouraging local investments.
- _ Improving the level of services provided for citizens and fairness in their distribution.

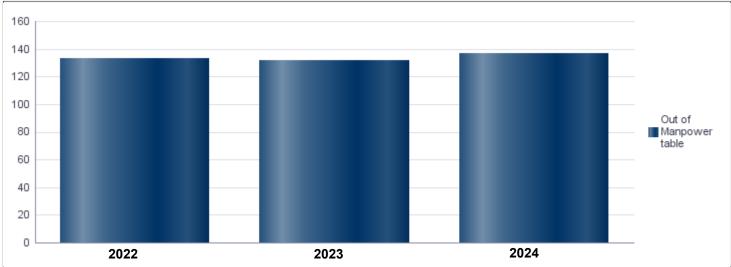
Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department :

- The decision to determine the use of the airport issued by the Civil Aviation Regulatory Authority on 2017/11/7 remains one of the main obstacles in the restoration of Amman Civil Airport As described above, this decision has led to a sharp and significant decline in air traffic and almost complete passenger numbers, at the same time, this decision prevented the company's ability to attract new investors and flight operators to Amman Civil Airport investor ", noting that many investors had vacated the invested sites at Amman Civil Airport.
- Despite the numerous speeches and attempts, the company has not yet been able to provide the necessary funding for the implementation of the Amman Civil Airport's aforementioned runway and air facilities rehabilitation projects estimated at (25) million JDs, as the appropriations allocated in the company's budget of capital projects are very limited and do not enable the company to proceed with the procedures of implementing the required projects
- _ Limited airspace positions. The Jordanian Airports Company occupies only 25% of the marina space (excluding the Gulf area).
- _ The state of the roads surrounding the airport and the need for traffic solutions.
- The state of architectural expansion surrounding Amman Airway where this constitutes an obstacle to the expansion of runways where needed.

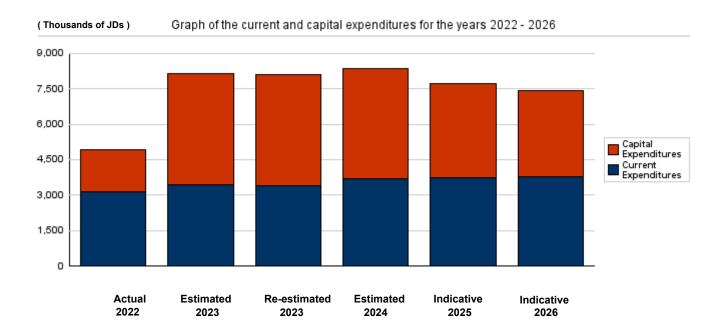
