## **Education and Human Resources Development Sector**

Key differences between the estimated appropriations for 2025 and the re-estimation for 2024 of the sector :

## **Current expenditure:**

- Current expenditures for the education and human resources development sector for 2025 increased higher than the 2024 re-estimation by approximately (116) million JDs, as follows:
- Compensations of employees group increased by approximately (42) million JDs to cover the cost of the annual increase and the cost of recruitment for vacancies and new jobs for 2025, the increase in the Ministry of Education was concentrated at approximately (39.1) million JDs.
- Use of goods and services group increased by about (23) million JDs and the increase was concentrated in most operational expenditure items. The increase in the use of goods and services group in the Ministry of Education was approximately (22) million JDs as a result of the provision for printing textbooks in current expenditures instead of capital expenditures.
- Other expenditures increased by approximately (51) million JDs. The increase is due to the allocation of the Royal Makrumeh allowances of teachers' children in current expenditures instead of capital expenditures in the amount of (20) million JDs within the budget of the Ministry of Education, as well as the allocation of the Student Support Fund in the amount of (30) million JDs in current expenditures instead of capital expenditures in the budget of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.

## Capital expenditure:

- Capital expenditures for 2025 increased compared with the re-estimation for 2024 by approximately (5.5) million JDs, mainly as a result of:
- Increased capital expenditures in the Ministry of Education by about (17.3) million JDs, despite the transfer and allocation of some capital expenditures within current expenditures, which represent Royal Makrumeh Allowances for teachers' children and the printing of school textbooks.
- Capital expenditures in the Ministry of Higher Education decreased by approximately (16.7) million JDs, as a result of the transfer of the Student Support Fund's allocation to be allocated within the current expenditure allocation.
- The Ministry of Labour's allocation increased by approximately (2.2) million JDs and was concentrated in increasing the allocation of the National Employment Programme project.
- The increase in the allocation of the Vocational Training Corporation by approximately (1.8) million JDs has been concentrated on raising the allocation of the project for the construction, maintenance, equipping and renovation of the buildings and training centres, the project for centres of excellence to develop skills and the allocation for decentralization projects.
- Increase in the allocation of the Vocational and Technical Skills Development Authority by approximately (0.9) million JDs, concentrated on increasing the allocation of educational, training and vocational and technical employment support projects.
