### Chapter: 2302 Ministry of Water and Irrigation/Jordan Valley Authority

- Creation : The Jordan Valley Authority was established under Temporary Jordan Valley Development Law No. (18) for the year 1977, which was then amended by Permanent Law No. (19) for the year 1988. Its area of responsibility was extended to cover the eastern coast of the Dead Sea, Southern Jordan Valley and Wadi Arabah. Jordan Valley Development Law was amended by Law No. (30) for the year 2001 to allow the selling of agricultural lands to the Jordanians and allow engagement of the private sector and management of completed projects on a commercial basis except for the transfer of property of the irrigation projects and water resources development projects.
- Vision : Sustainable water and land sources to achieve the inclusive development.
- Mission : Managing, developing, and protecting the water sources, shared water, for all purposes and lands in the Jordan Valley in order to contribute to the Valley's development, preserve its environment and create an investment environment in partnership with the private sector.
- Legal Framework : Jordan Valley Development Law No. (19) for the year 1988 and amendments thereto.

Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2025 - 2027 :

- Developing and exploiting Jordan Valley water sources for irrigated agriculture, domestic use, municipal affairs, industry, electricity generation and other useful purposes.

- Settling disputes arising out of using water sources.
- Organizing and directing the establishment of private and public wells.

- The development, protection and improvement of the valley's environment and the implementation of all necessary actions to this end and the development of structural and detailed organizational schemes for land beyond municipal regulatory boundaries.
- Studying, designing, establishing and maintaining the valley's agricultural road networks. The Authority should continue to monitor the implementation of the main roads that have been initiated and have not yet been completed.
- Developing tourism in the valley and identifying areas with advantages that can be exploited for tourist and recreational purposes, developing these areas and establishing tourist and recreational facilities.
- With the exception of irrigation projects and water resources development projects, the Authority shall follow the commercial bases in the management of any of the projects it has completed or is carrying out in accordance with instructions issued by the Council of Ministers on the placement of the Council.
- The Authority may, by decision of the Council of Ministers, upon placement of the Council, entrust any of the projects it has completed, carried out or managed and any investment project in the Valley to any entity in the private sector for rental, administration or operation in accordance with the legislation in force and transfer of ownership, excluding irrigation projects and water resources development projects.

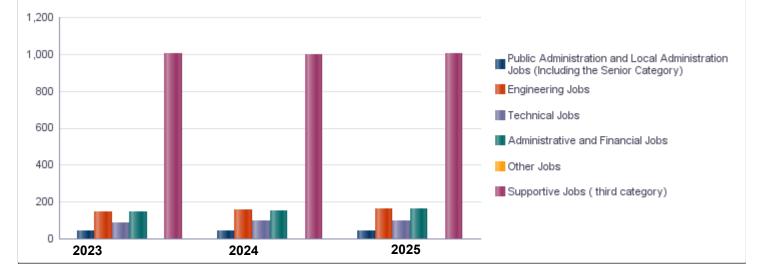

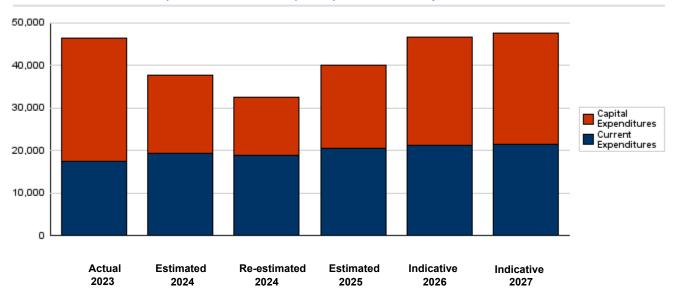
