#### Chapter: 2803 Higher Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities

Creation: The Higher Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities was established under Disabled

Persons Rights Law No. (31) for the year 2007. It was called "The Higher Council for Disabled Persons Affairs". In 2017, the Persons with Disabilities Rights Law No. (20) for the year 2017 was issued and by which the name of the Council was modified to "the Higher Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities" forming the institutional and legal umbrella for disabled persons in the

Kingdom.

Vision: A national specialized effective and integrating establishment to enhance the rights of

handicapped persons in all aspects of life.

Mission: Change leadership for integrating handicapped persons in all aspects of life through following up

and monitoring their conditions continuously and proposing relevant policies through connceting with relevant authorities and providing the necessary technical support to enforce the law of the rights of persons with disabilities and empower them and ensure the quality of services provided

for them.

Legal Framework: Law on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities No. (20) for the year 2017.

Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2025 - 2027:

#### First Priority:

- A society that is aware of the rights and importance of inclusion of persons with disabilities and provides them with the necessary support to enable them to participate fully in all aspects of life.

#### Key procedures to achieve the first priority:

- Conducting comprehensive awareness-raising campaigns targeting decision makers in government bodies on the importance of supporting the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Inclusion of new items related to persons with disabilities in the training programmes of the new employees.
- Developing e-learning platforms to train the public and private sector along with the community on the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Developing existing award policies and standards to become more inclusive.
- Activating the ID card in all government institutions.

#### First Priority Outcomes:

- Promoting community awareness, changing attitudes about the Council's role and the rights of persons with disabilities and changing stereotypes about them.
- Promoting, stimulating and documenting positive community practices on the rights of persons with disabilities.

#### First priority-related program:

- Rights of persons with disabilities.

#### **Second Priority:**

- Active partners allocating funds from budgets for project implementation, providing services to persons with disabilities, providing a legislative environment that guarantees their rights and working towards an environment that is inclusive and just for them, in addition to supporting the Council's directions in the implementation of rights projects through donors and international organizations.

#### Key procedures to achieve the second priority:

- Conducting comprehensive awareness-raising campaigns targeting decision makers in government bodies on the importance of supporting the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Inclusion in new staff training programmes of materials on the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Developing e-learning platforms to train the public and private sector along with the community on the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Developing existing award policies and standards to become more inclusive.
- Activating the ID card in all government institutions.

#### **Second Priority Outcomes:**

- Enhancing the awareness and training of government officials and workers on the rights of persons with disabilities and promoting the employment and participation of persons with disabilities within government institutions to ensure their effective representation in policies and programmes.
- Contributing to the development and updating of national policies and legislation to ensure their compatibility with the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and monitoring and evaluating the implementation of policies and legislation.
- Providing a comprehensive national database on persons with disabilities in collaboration with government agencies to improve planning and policies.

#### Second priority-related program:

- Administration and Support Services

#### **Third Priority:**

- Enabling and supportive organizations implementing projects to meet the requirements of community integration of persons with disabilities.

#### Key procedures to achieve the third priority:

- Designing a programme to develop the capacity of disabled persons' organizations and organizations active in the development of disability advocacy schemes.
- Implementing specialized annual workshops and training programmes to develop the capacity of disabled persons' organizations in relation to the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Providing technical and financial support to persons with disabilities and organizations active in the field of disability in the implementation of training or pilot programmes aiming at promoting the integration of persons with disabilities.

#### **Third Priority Outcomes:**

- Providing training and development to organizations supporting persons with disabilities on how to meet the integration requirements of persons with disabilities.

#### Third priority-related program:

- Rights of persons with disabilities

#### Fourth Priority:

- A participating private sector that provides appropriate employment opportunities and an inclusive working environment, taking into account the accessibility of persons with disabilities and integrating their issues into community responsibility strategies and designing and developing products and services that meet the needs of persons with disabilities and enhance their ability to participate actively in society.

#### Key procedures to achieve the fourth priority:

- Organization of annual training programmes between the Council and the private sector.
- Organizing periodic events aimed at guiding the private sector's efforts to support the participation of persons with disabilities and women with economic disabilities.
- Signing cooperation agreements with companies to adopt inclusive policies and practices towards persons with disabilities.

#### **Fourth Priority Outcomes:**

- Promoting corporate social responsibility to support the rights of persons with disabilities.
- Ensuring job opportunities for persons with disabilities, while ensuring that facilitative arrangements are in place to integrate them into different aspects of life.

#### fourth priority-related program:

- Rights of persons with disabilities

#### Priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- Supporting persons with disabilities and their organizations to be leaders in society and achieving an inclusive and enhanced environment for the rights of persons with disabilities of both genders.

#### Key procedures to achieve the priority of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- Preparing a guide on how to address gender-based violence and the rights of persons with disabilities in Jordan.
- Developing gender-sensitive films based on the guideline.
- The establishment of the Women's Committee in the Council, which is competent to deal with the issues of women with disabilities.

#### The following outcomes are expected to be achieved for the priority of gender, youth & persons with disabilities

- Implementation of the findings and recommendations of the annual report to monitor the situations and rights of persons with disabilities issued by the Council by all relevant bodies.
- Developing executive plans, procedures and programs to promote the participation of persons with disabilities and their organizations in the society.

#### Priority-related program of gender, youth and persons with disabilities:

- Rights of persons with disabilities.

#### Tasks of the Ministry / Department :

- Suggesting the general policy for the rights of persons with disabilities and reaching them to different services and submit it to the cabinet for approval after the Board of Trustees approval, it shall provide the necessary plans and programs for their implementation.
- Proposing laws and bylaws related to the Council's tasks.
- Providing technical support for government ministries and entities and national institutions in setting their strategies, plans and programs to ensure their coverage of persons with disabilities rights.
- Coordinating with government ministries and entities and national institutions to identify the roles and specializations in the field of disability and methods of information and expertise exchange to realize integrated efforts.
- Following up and monitoring related authorities application of the provisions of this law and relevant national strategies and persons with disabilities rights agreement.
- Monitoring the conditions of persons with disability and their rights on the national level and verifying the individual and institutional complaints related to discrimination according to disability.
- Issuing the standards stipulated in this law, holding training thereof and controlling the adherence of authorities concerned with their application.
- Conducting a comprehensive and specialized studies and surveys of persons with disabilities and evaluating provided services and their accessibility in coordination with concerned authorities.
- Concluding agreements and memos of understanding with government and non-government authorities and following up their implementation.
- Forming permanent and temporary committees and approving the results of their work and identifying the bonuses of their members as per the effective legislations.

#### Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives:

- Supporting persons with disabilities in all community activities.
- Promoting respect for disadvantaged and marginalized categories.
- Expanding social utilization, empowerment and protection for the persons with disabilities.
- Providing the legal protection of the persons with disabilities.

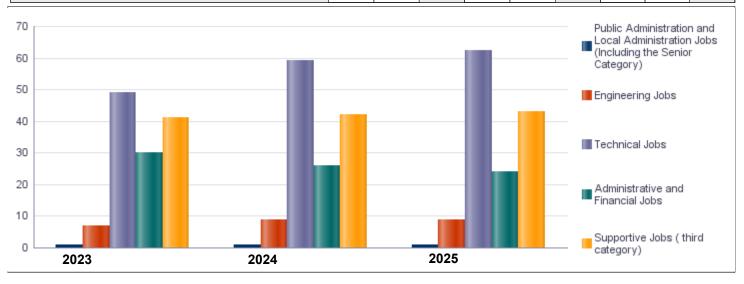
#### Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department :

- The need for a mechanism to coordinate efforts between partners and donors to implement disability-related sector strategy items to ensure unity of effort and reduce overlap in roles and responsibilities.
- Limited financial resources for the implementation of the obligations and functions provided for by law.
- Increased demand for technical support services provided by the Council's partners, requiring the Council to be staffed with specialized technical personnel in several areas such as inclusive tourism accessibility, inclusive education, alternatives to accommodation, follow-up and evaluation of communication and networking strategies and the subjection of the Council's technical cadres to specialized technical courses in, inter alia, inclusive tourism s rights ", the impact of climate change on persons with disabilities, sexual and reproductive health and others.
- The need to strengthen the role of persons with disabilities in defending, lobbying and developing their capacities in this area.
- The lack of a comprehensive database of persons with disabilities in partners, which allows them to be built upon in the preparation of strategic plans for associated projects.
- Low investment in and provision of supportive technology in employment and education for persons with disabilities.
- The prevailing stereotype of persons with disabilities in society and the poor media treatment of the issues and rights of persons with disabilities.

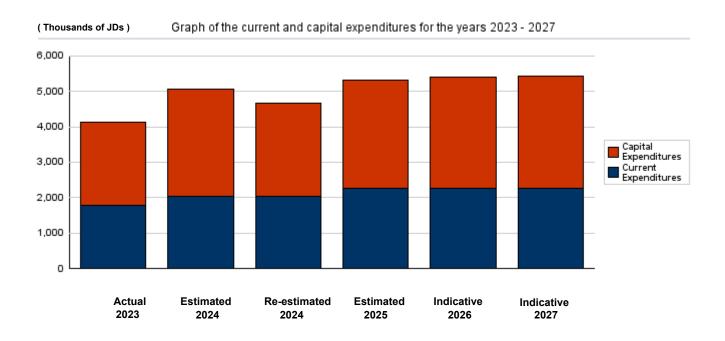

- Raising awareness of the right to work for employers and networking with the Ministry of Labour and activating the role of labour and training inspectors;
- Coordination and follow-up with partners to implement the Law on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.
- Providing devices and technologies that enable persons with disabilities to access digital transformation services.

#### Gender:

The Council is committed to achieving gender equality and community integration. This shall be taken into account in the implementation of programmes and all projects and activities arising therefrom.

The program is implemented through a functional staff in 2024 estimated with (13) staff, including (4) males and (9) females.
