Chapter: 8173 Constitutional Court

Creation: Constitutional amendments of 2011/10/1 approved a chapter on the establishment of the

Constitutional Court in articles 58, 59, 60 and 61, and issued Law No. (15) of 2012 on 6/10/2012 in which Article 58 of the Constitutional Amendments stipulates that: "A Constitutional Court shall be established by law and shall be based in the capital and shall be regarded as a separate judicial body consisting of at least nine members, including the President appointed by the King." In his directives to amend the Constitution, His Majesty the King emphasized her important role in the process of reform, a major step towards strengthening the principle of separation of powers, stopping the authorities from overlooking each other and defending people's freedoms and rights in the manner set forth in the Constitution, especially after its amendment to international

standards in the exercise of these rights and freedoms.

Vision: Rule of law and supremacy of constitution thereby protecting the rights and freedoms of

individuals and community service locally and internationally.

Mission: Monitoring the institutionalization of applicable laws and regulations and the interpretation of

constituition texts and protecting the rights of individuals through independent judicial

commission with high integrity and justice.

Legal Framework: Jordanian Constitution and Constitutional Court Law No. (15) for the year 2012 and amendments

thereto.

- Work to consolidate the principle of the supremacy of the Constitution by monitoring the constitutionality of laws and bylaws in force and interpreting the provisions of the duly enforced Jordanian Constitution.

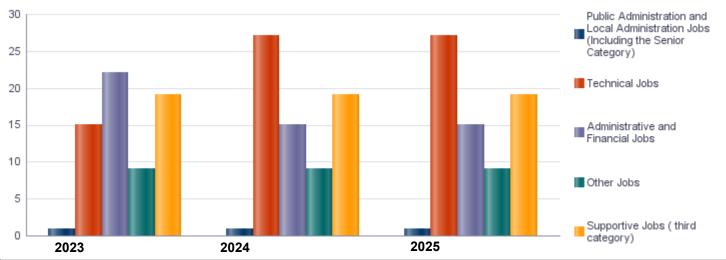

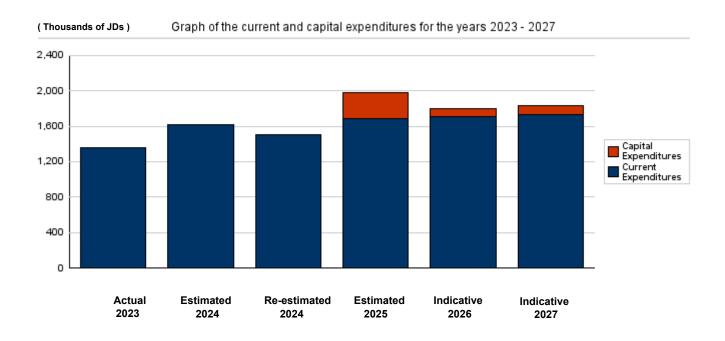
