Creation: The Jordan Center for Disease Control was established pursuant to Bylaw No. (112) of 2020, issued

pursuant to Article (120) of the Jordanian Constitution. The Center enjoys legal personality with financial and administrative independence and has the right to own movable and immovable

property, conclude contracts and accept donations, grants and wills.

Vision: Excellence and innovation in the fields of public health fields in terms of monitoring, prevention,

research, evaluation and policy direction.

Mission: The Jordan Center for Disease Control leads and coordinates the national efforts to prevent and

fight diseases and face public health challenges through partnership with relevant entities to strengthen Jordan's capacity to combat disease, promote health security, monitor and respond to

diseases, and promote evidence-based policies and decisions.

Legal Framework : Jordan Center for Disease Control Bylaw No.(112) for 2020.

Priorities and targeted results within the determined ceilings for the years 2025 - 2027 :

First Priority:

- Strengthening the Center's role as a key entity for combating and mitigating epidemics and health threats and building capacity on public health issues in Jordan.

Key procedures to achieve the first priority:

- Developing health policies, strategies and evidence for monitoring, prevention and control of epidemics and communicable diseases, and other health issues within the single health concept, as well as environmental threats related to health.
- Coordinating and monitoring efforts to combat epidemics, communicable diseases and other health and environmental threats.
- Contributing to national and international research programmes on public health issues.
- Providing high-quality capacity-building programmes for public health professionals.

First Priority Outcomes:

- The Center's institutional and well-established role as a key national entity for the prevention, preparedness, control, mitigation and enhancement of health security.
- Access to standard operational policies, strategies and procedures based on scientific and public health research and evidence at the national and international levels.
- National efforts targeted for the prevention and control of communicable and non-communicable diseases in a coordinated and practical manner.

First priority-related program:

- Epidemic control.

Second Priority:

- Promoting, supporting and using high-quality monitoring data to guide evidence-based national public health policies and practices.

Key procedures to achieve the second priority:

- Supporting the development of an integrated multisectoral national monitoring system.
- Follow-up, analysis, interpretation and exchange of national monitoring data.

Second Priority Outcomes:

- An integrated, multisectoral national laboratory epidemiological monitoring system is in effective use.
- High-quality epidemiological and laboratory monitoring data used to support evidence-based national decisions and policies.

Second priority-related program:

- Epidemic control.

Third Priority:

- Promoting and activating the laboratory network with roles and responsibilities at all levels while linking data directly to the monitoring system.

Key procedures to achieve the third priority:

- Strengthening national capacity and efficiency to detect, monitor and confirm prevalent and emerging diseases.
- Coordination with national laboratories' efforts and control to link laboratory data to the monitoring system.

Third Priority Outcomes:

- National reference laboratory and effective laboratory network at all levels with data associated with the monitoring system.
- Enhanced national capabilities and capacities to detect, monitor and confirm emerging and widespread diseases through the Center's laboratory..

Third priority-related program:

- Control of epidemics

Fourth Priority:

- Strengthening national capacities in public health emergency preparedness, response and resilience.

Key procedures to achieve the fourth priority:

- Developing health policies, strategies and guides for health emergency preparedness.
- Coordinating and monitoring the national efforts to prepare for and respond to public health emergencies with all relevant authorities.

Fourth Priority Outcomes:

- Health policies, strategies and standard operating procedures prepared for public health emergencies and responding to them and dealing with them flexibly.
- Coordinated and targeted national efforts to respond and prepare for public health emergencies.

fourth priority-related program:

- Control of epidemics

Priority of climate change:

- Monitoring and assessing the severity and impact of epidemics, communicable diseases and health threats, including environmental, agricultural and animal-based issues, including insect-borne diseases.

Key procedures to achieve climate change-related priority:

- Undertakingstudies on the severity and impact of epidemics, communicable diseases and health threats related to environmental and animal-based issues, including insect-borne diseases, within a single-health approach.
- Developing the monitoring and surveillance system and updating threat standards.
- Development and operation of GIS at the national level.

The following outcomes are expected to be achieved for the priority of climate change:

- Reports on the severity and impact of epidemics, communicable diseases and health threats.
- List of threat standards and monitoring and surveillance system.
- Active geographic information system.

Program of climate change-related priority:

- Administration and Support Services.
- Epidemic control.

Tasks of the Ministry / Department :

- Developing and recommending to the competent authorities health policies to combat epidemics and communicable diseases.
- Monitoring epidemics and communicable diseases nationally, regionally and internationally, detecting new or emerging threats and recommending their prevention through coordination and cooperation with relevant agencies.
- Coordinating efforts to respond to epidemics, pandemics and other health threats and implementing health contingency plans by monitoring and following up environmental health threats and their relationship to epidemics and communicable diseases.
- Providing reference diagnosis services for individuals, society and health institutions.
- Monitoring and improving the Kingdom's levels of vaccination and expanding the base of those covered therein, in cooperation with the relevant authorities.
- Leading health efforts aimed at preventing and combating epidemics, communicable diseases and their disabilities in accordance with global standards and the recommendations of international health bodies, including the World Health Organization..
- Performing the scientific research, provide and analyze health information.
- Building the capacity of the Center's cadres, qualifying and training them and training personnel in combating epidemics and communicable diseases and rehabilitating them through the provision of professional and academic programs in cooperation and coordination with relevant agencies locally, regionally and internationally.

Ministry/Department Contribution to the Achievement of the National Objectives :

- Strengthening public health practices in the prevention and preparedness for combating epidemics and communicable diseases, including terrorist biological threats.
- Promoting accurate health and environmental behaviours and the Kingdom's potentials in health monitoring.
- Developing health information systems.
- Taking the necessary measures to prevent the dissemination of epidemics and communicable diseases.

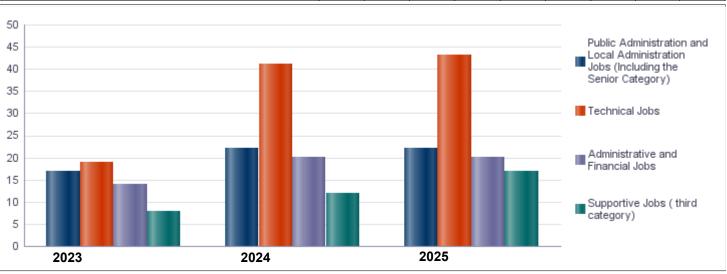
Major Issues and Challenges which face the Ministry / Department :

- The political instability in the region may lead to shifting focus from general health to response to emergency one again.
- The difficulty of coordinating with other laboratories and the Central Laboratory of Public Health in obtaining samples to be examined in the Center's laboratories.
- Difficulties in routinely exchanging information and data between sectors on co-morbidities events.
- The increase in the number of refugees in the Kingdom increases the likelihood of transmitting and spreading epidemic diseases.
- Getting data and information on time.
- Decentralized documentation of information, data and multiple sources.

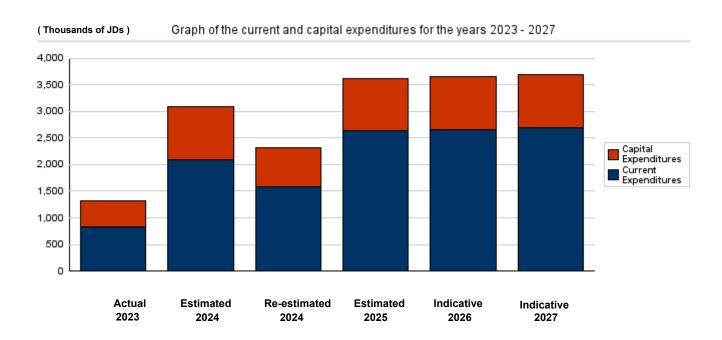
